Malawi College of Health Sciences is pleased to announce training opportunities in the following upgrading programmes: Diploma in Pharmacy, University Certificate in Midwifery, Diploma in Anaesthesia and Intensive Care Medicine, Diploma in Community Health Nursing, Diploma in Ophthalmology and Advanced Diploma in Clinical Ophthalmology (Cataract Surgery) in the 2024/2025 Academic Year.

## 1. DIPLOMA IN PHARMACY: 18 MONTHS

#### Admission requirements

Applicants must have a Certificate in Pharmacy, be registered with the Pharmacy and Medicines Regulatory Authority (PMRA), and have served for at least two years. Applicants must have a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with a credit pass in English. Candidates must also have passes in the following subjects: Mathematics, Biology and Physical Science (Physics & Chemistry). Two of these must be credit passes. Mode of delivery: Weekends

# 2. DIPLOMA IN ANAESTHESIA AND INTENSIVE CARE MEDICINE

#### Admission requirements

Applicants must be qualified Medical Assistants or Nurse Midwife Technicians who have served for a minimum of four years. Applicants must also have a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with a credit pass in English. Candidates must have passes in the following subjects: Mathematics, Biology and Physical Science (Physics and Chemistry). Two of these must be credit passes. Applicants must be registered with the Medical Council of Malawi or the Nurses and Midwives Council of Malawi. Mode of Delivery: Normal

## 3. UNIVERSITY CERTIFICATE IN MIDWIFERY

#### Admission requirements

Applicants must have diploma or degree in Registered Nursing obtained from a recognized institution, and Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with 6 credits. Four (4) of the credit passes must be in the following subjects: English, Mathematics, Biology and Physical Science or Physics and Chemistry. Two (2) of the credit passes must be in any 2 subjects. The applicants should also be

registered with Nurses and Midwives Council of Malawi and should have a current practicing license. Mode of Delivery: Normal

## 4. DIPLOMA IN COMMUNITY HEALTH NURSING: 12 MONTHS

#### Admission requirements

Applicants must be qualified Nursing Midwifery Technicians with a minimum of 3 years' experience and currently registered with the Nurses and Midwives Council of Malawi. Applicants must also produce evidence of having obtained a Malawi School Certificate of Education or its equivalent. Mode of delivery: Normal

# 5. DIPLOMA IN CLINICAL OPHTHALMOLOGY: 18 MONTHS

#### Admission requirements

Applicants must be qualified Medical Assistants who have served for a minimum of two years. Applicants must also have a Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with a credit pass in English. Candidates must also have passes in the following subjects: Mathematics, Biology and Physical Science (Physics & Chemistry). Two of these must be credit passes. Applicants must be registered with the Medical Council of Malawi. Mode of Delivery: Normal

### ADVANCED DIPLOMA IN CLINICAL OPHTHALMOLOGY (CATARACT SURGERY): 12/18 MONTHS

## Admission requirements for local students

Applicants must have a Diploma in Clinical Medicine, Diploma in Clinical Ophthalmology as well as Malawi School Certificate (MSCE) or its equivalent and must have worked for not less than two years. Applicants must be registered with the Medical Council of Malawi. Mode of Delivery: Normal

## Admission requirements for International Students

Applicants must have a Diploma in Clinical Ophthalmology, Diploma in Ophthalmic Nursing as well as A Levels or any qualification equivalent to Malawi School Certificate (MSCE) and must have worked for not less than two years. Applicants must be registered with relevant registration bodies in their countries. Mode of Delivery: Normal
